The Dartmoor National Park Authority (Bridleway No. 16 Bovey Tracey) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 2024

- 1. Dartmoor National Park Authority makes this Order in exercise of its powers under section 22BB(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as applied by the National Park Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure)(England) Regulations 2007.
- 2. The Order shall come into operation on 1 September 2024 for a period of 6 months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the sooner.
- 3. The restriction specified will only have effect at such times and to such extent as indicated by the display of notices.
- 4. The duration of the Order can be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.
 - While the Order is in operation no person shall proceed along Bridleway No.16 (Bovey Tracey) from Grid Reference SX 7884 7897 to SX 7914 7843 during such times as the appropriate traffic signs are displayed. There is no alternative route available.
- 5. In this order 'traffic sign' means any sign or notice erected on the Bridleway by the Authority pursuant to section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
